

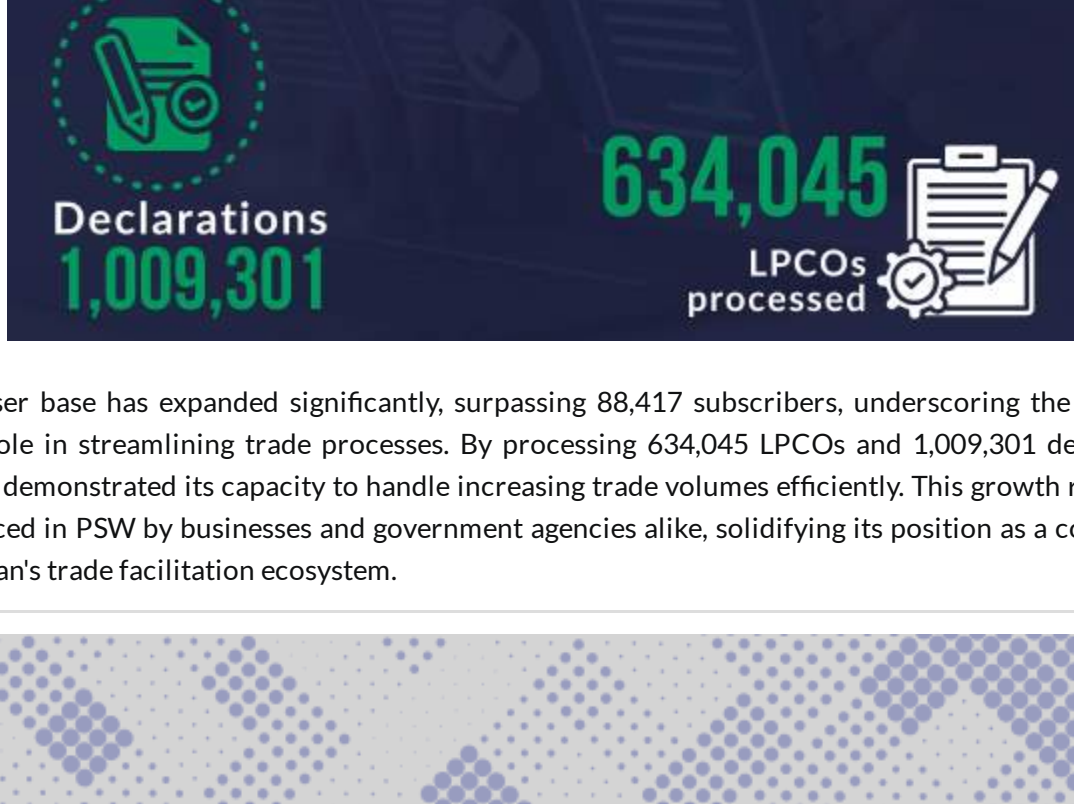

PSW Conducts National Workshop on Airport Community System (ACS) to Digitalize Air Cargo Operations

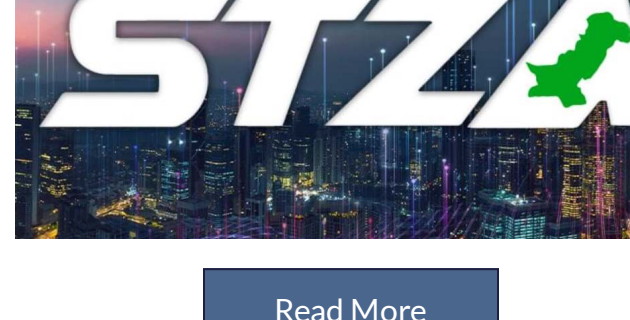

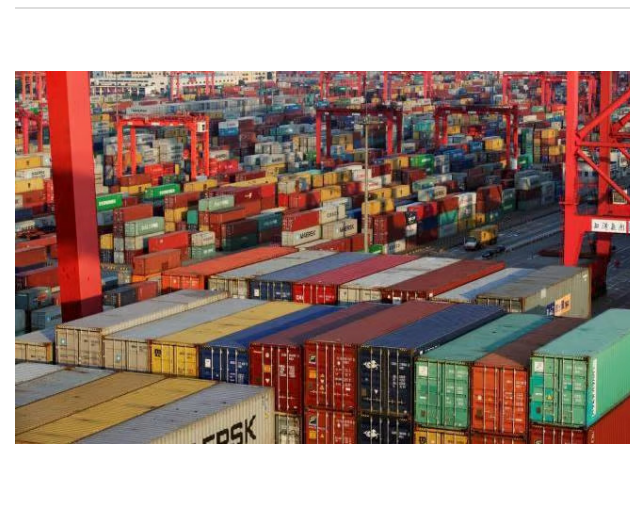
Rules For Utilizing Pakistan Single Window Amended

The Federal Board of Revenue (FBR) has mandated that Special Technology Zones Authority (STZA) licensees must utilize the Pakistan Single Window (PSW) system for import clearance under the concessionary regime. As per SRO140 of 2025, STZA licensees are required to submit the ANW for compliance with the Pakistan Single Window Act 2021. The system will facilitate automated tracking of imported goods and ensure regulatory compliance. Additionally, Customs authorities may restrict user access in case of rule violations, reinforcing transparency and accountability in trade processes.

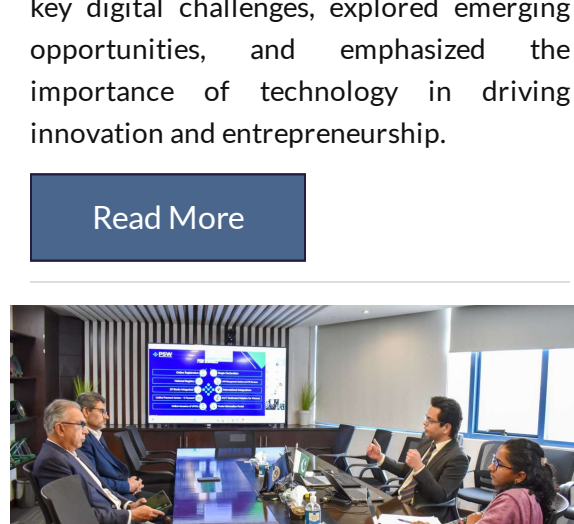

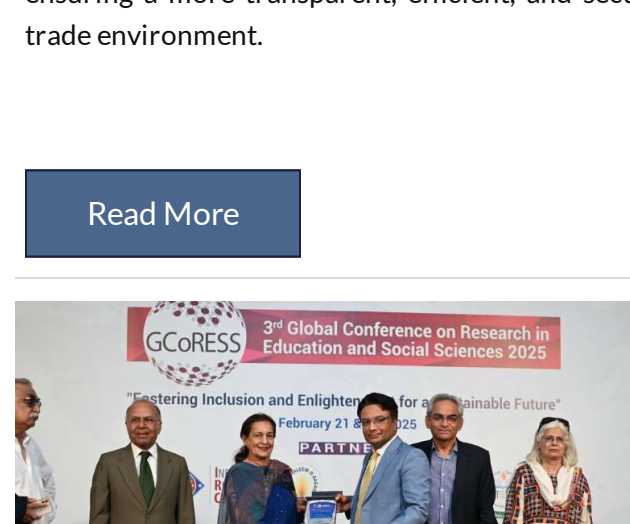
